# **Project Based Learning**

During our PBL lessons, students are beginning the making process of their project. They have all decided on a project and completed a plan, now it is time for them to implement their plans.

#### Health

We will learn to describe and apply strategies that can be used in situations that make students feel uncomfortable or unsafe. We will look at what it means to feel safe and locate places in which students can go in order to be safe.



#### Art

In art, we are still working on our artworks to tell a story. We have looked at the styles of impressionism and realism and we will use these to help create our piece.

### History

We are continuing our work on the first fleet. We have plotted the journey the Europeans took, and have found the reasons why they needed to come to Australia. We are creating a poster each to showcase all the information about the First Fleet that we have learned.

#### **Mathematics**

The concepts we will be covering in mathematics for the second half of the term include:

- 1. **Length** Estimate, measure and compare lengths using centimetres and millimetres and convert between units.
- 2. **2D shapes** Identify and describe common features of 2D shapes. Investigate the effects of combining or splitting shapes.
- 3. **Equivalent fractions** Use diagrams and fraction walls to investigate and identify equivalent fractions.
- 4. Improper fractions and mixed numbers Understand and convert between fractions and mixed numbers using number lines and diagrams.

For the remaining part of the term, we will be exploring food and fibre production and looking into how they meet consumer needs.
