Welcome back everyone to an exciting Term 2. I hope everyone is well rested after the holidays and are ready to learn. We've got a jam packed term, which I am very excited about.

English -

In writing this term, we are starting off looking at Poetry. The students will create their own poetry portfolio with 10 different types of poems in there. I hope everyone is ready to get their creative juices flowing.

Art -

In Art we will be exploring the use of line, colour and shapes within a piece of art.

Health -

In Health, we will be exploring situations and how they may make us feel. We will look at ways we can remain safe, and different things we can do to help ourselves.





Maths -

In Maths, we are covering several different concepts, explained below.

IMPROPER FRACTION -

Understand and convert between fractions and mixed numbers using number lines and diagrams. SUBTRACTION MENTAL STRATEGIES -Explore and choose appropriate mental subtraction strategies such as the compensation strategy and rounding to solve subtraction problems.

TIME -

Investigate and record am and pm time to the minute. Convert between common units of time.

Religious Education -

Throughout the first 5 weeks of term we will have a strong focus on the Eucharist. Students will be taught the meaning of Eucharist and what it means to receive their First Eucharist.

Digital Technologies -

Through digital technologies we will be looking at how technology has changed over time. We will compare technology past and present. We'll then explore what a digital system is and how to use software.
