During Term Three it is always exciting to see the children's learning and personal growth accelerating as they begin to apply all that they have learnt so far to new challenges with more confidence and independence.

#### What are we learning at the moment?

As we 'wrap up' our Aboriginal topic by revisiting our 'big question' - what is special to the Aboriginal people of Australia, the students are able to name several important aspects of the Aboriginal culture demonstrating respect for diversity, a keen interest in cultures different to their own and hopefully seek further opportunities to ask more 'wonder questions'!

In Religion lessons we have been exploring the gift of life and how we can appreciate and share this gift with others. We also learn how Jesus came to show us how to enjoy life as God intended.

In literacy we have been enjoying stories about fathers and sharing all the wonderful and funny things about our own dads. The students have been very clever during writing sessions this term, writing procedures to explain how to complete something and sharing their ideas about their fathers and Aboriginal culture. Our next writing challenge will be to learn how to write an exciting narrative!

In Maths sessions the children have been investigating 3D shapes, numbers beyond ten and simple addition and subtraction strategies. Shapes and numbers are certainly all around us everywhere we go!
