English

Throughout English for the rest of the term, we will be learning about 2 different styles of writing. We will continue working on how to write a recount. Once we have mastered that, we will move on to learning how to write a review.

Health

In Health we have had a focus on feelings and the ways we can treat other people. For the rest of the term, we will keep the focus of feelings and find ways to identify what we are feeling and ways to manage our emotions.

Digital Technologies

We are very excited in Digital Technologies to be using a coding program called Scratch. Using this program, we will create our own animations of stories we have written.

Maths

Symmetry - Use transformations to investigate and create symmetrical patterns.

Decimal Fractions - Read, write and interpret numbers to hundredths and convert between decimals and fractions.

Multiplication Written Strategies - Explore and choose appropriate written multiplication strategies such as extended and contracted multiplication to solve problems involving one and two-digit numbers.

Civics and Citizenship

During Civics & Citizenship lessons we will be continuing the work we have been doing since the beginning of term in analysing the difference between rules and laws. We will look at our own rules and laws and what happens if we don't follow these.

Religious Education

In Religious Education we will be thinking about our own consciences and looking at how our consciences calls us to do good. We will learn that Jesus followed his conscience to do what is right and realise that Baptism and blessing ourselves with Holy water are reminders to follow our conscience.

Art
