Welcome back to another busy term. I can't believe how quickly the year has flown by and we are already into the final term of the year. English

In English this term we will be exploring how to write explanations. Students will research sustainability issues and write an explanation on the topic of their choice.



MATHS

Week 1 - Volume & Capacity - Estimate, measure and compare volume and capacity using cubic centimetres, litres and millilitres. Convert between litres and millilitres.

Week 2 & 3 - Division written strategies - Explore and choose appropriate written division strategies such as short division to solve problems involving one and two digit numbers.

Week 4 - 3D Objects - Identify and describe 3D objects including top, front and side views. Sketch and name common 3D objects.

Week 5 & 6 - Chance events & chance experiments - Compare, rank and evaluate the likelihood of common events. Predict and explore the possible outcomes of chance experiments and evaluate the effects of one event on another.

HEALTH

In Health this term we will be learning about what is private and public, and how to be cyber safe.

CIVICS AND CITIZENSHIP

Our focus in Civics and Citizenship for this term is on shires and their responsibilities. We will look at the different services supplied by the shire and look specifically at the Shire of Manjimup.

DIGITAL TECHNOLOGY

Continuing on from last term, students will be working on their animated stories. Students have made up storyboards with characters and are now in the process of coding to create these stories into animation.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION
