Curriculum and Teaching Units

Homework

- Aligned to what the students are learning in class.
- Weekly. Weeks 1-9 (usually)
- Homework book-Handed to students on Monday to be completed and handed to me by Friday.
- If the student cannot complete homework. Parents to sign pages allocated.
- Develop a routine for students.

Homework

- Homework book
 - Homework sheet send home weekly on a Monday.
 - Choice of 4 activities – all to be completed by Friday.
- Reading
 - Any book
 - Fill out reading log section on sheet, sign each night.
- Diaries
