### Lots of Learning

We have had lots of fun in the first half of the term exploring "What Makes Me, Me?" From this inquiry we started to wonder how we are different to babies, toddlers and older children. This will be the continuation of our inquiry for the remainder of the term.

In English we are beginning to explore narratives. We will read narratives, and create our own spoken narratives. While in Mathematics, we have completed our first iMaths investigation "Ozanimal Olympics" and are ready for a new investigation, "Good Night Sleep Tight", where we will learn about reading time. Following this, we will learn about 2D shapes and some more number skills.

#### Lent and Easter Liturgy

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During Religion the focus for the remainder of the term will be Easter and Lent with a focus on the "New Life" that we receive at Easter when Jesus rises from the dead.

We are also looking forward to presenting the Easter Liturgy for the whole school on the final day of term.
