RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

- Subtraction Represent and solve simple subtraction problems using a range of strategies including counting on, partitioning and rearranging parts.
- Measurement Compare and order several shapes and objects based on length, area, volume and capacity using appropriate uniform informal units.

Within this unit, we will be exploring how to use mapping skills to identify key features in our home. This unit will be integrated into our Language Studies and Visual Arts program.
