English and Maths

In English we are concluding our study of information texts with writing reports about a chosen item of interest. The final copies will be compiled into a book for the classes Library corner. We are continuing with the Pre-Lit and PLD spelling programs and will begin studying the use of rhyme in texts and poetry.

In Maths we have begun exploring the special mathematical language and terms used in measurement. We have explored how to compare the length of different objects and will shortly start to explore and compare the mass and area of objects.


Religion
