Back into it for Term 4

It was wonderful to see all of the children's smiling faces and hear their happy greetings as we returned to school last week for our final term of 2020. The children all shared some great stories about the fun they go up to over the holidays and have settled straight back into the routine of our classroom.

English and Maths

In English, we have started the term focusing on telling and writing recounts of fun events that happened over the school holidays. We are now turning our attention to revising how to write information reports with a research report about an Australian animal. This is closely linked to our Maths Investigation.

We have started an investigation in Maths called "Animal Recuse". We are designing a new habitat for some misplaced Australian animals. Cach child will design their own habitats and a map showing the positions that different animals will be rehomed.

Inquiry

Our HASS inquiry for this term focuses on the question "Where do we live and why is it special?".

We have started looking at this from the big picture of the globe and world maps. We have asked the questions "Where are some places in the world and what is the globe?" Last week we shared our own ideas and questions about the world (globe) and maps. The children used different natural materials to each create their own model world using the large world map in the inquiry area and how it used different colours to represent different parts of the world as their inspiration.

Religion

We will continue to explore the special sacrament of Baptism and how we are all members of God's family and the Church.

We will also spend some time reviewing Reconciliation and First Communion as the Year 3 and 4 students receive these sacraments for the first time during the term. Towards the end of the term, we will turn our attention to that very special event; the birth of Jesus and Christmas.
