# Lots of Learning

We have lots of engaging and interesting learning experiences planned for the start of the term. In Religion we will start with a unit about Prayer. We will learn how prayer is a way of talking with God and even make some of our own prayers to share with the class.

In English we will have a strong focus on our speaking and listening skills and begin to learn the structure of recounts. In Mathematics we will be exploring many early number concepts and skills and the Year Ones will begin to learn about numbers to 100 and their place value.

# Reptile Incursion

Our first inquiry for the year "The Sun Changes Everything" is closely linked to the Science, Geography arm manning areas. We will begin by investigating "How does the sun helps reptiles?" To help us learn more about reptiles next Monday 15<sup>th</sup> February we have a mini-incursion planned with a visit from a local reptile rescuer who will show us some local reptiles and explain what needs reptiles need to stay healthy.

# Library Day

Each Wednesday Mr Kelly takes the class for a Library lesson. During these lessons the students listen to a story and have the opportunity to borrow a book from the library.
