LOTS OF LEARNING CONTINUING

It's hard to believe we are already halfway through Term 2! Here is a snapshot of our learning for the remainder of the term...

Inquiry: Our inquiry "What makes a place special?" is in full swing, with students getting ready to explore if there are common features to our special places before working out how we can help take care of our special places around town.

Religion: Our new Unit focuses on the Eucharist and explores how belonging to groups helps us feel connected and, by going to Church, Jesus helps us belong to the Church community.

Maths: We have been busy learning about the days of the week and different times of day. We will conclude the term with our first investigation exploring groups of ten, 2D and 3D shapes while creating mathematical masterpieces.

Literacy: We will continue with our shared and individualised spelling and reading programmes, and begin to explore the genre of procedure writing.

Art: We have had fun discovering how primary colours mix to make wonderful new colours. We begin to use these colours to create artworks with different moods/feelings.

Music: We will continue learning beat and rhythm through singing, movement songs and games and will soon create, record and perform our own rhythms using various objects and actions for ideas.
