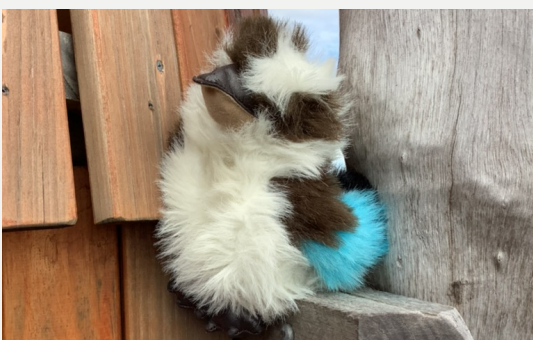
## CLASSROOM LEARNING

We will also continue to focus on a range of other skills across the learning areas.

In **Spelling** the Pp's will keep working on their spelling digraphs and sight words and the K's will begin to identify the beginning sounds in words and blending them with rimes.
